### 2021 LIMITED ROSÉ

Pale pink, the 2021 Limited Rosé smells of zesty citrus notes, almond blossom and honeysuckle. The mouthfeel is fresh and crisp with delicate notes of white peach, grapefruit and kiwi and finishes with a tin saline layer.

	<i>Harvest Date(s)</i>	Mid to late September and the 12th of October
	<i>Vintage Notes</i>	2021 gave us mild temperatures for a consistent and slow growing season, which pushed harvest a bit behind the historical average. With a dry winter and a cool spring, bud break was delayed. The warm summer promoted good veraison onset. When harvest rolled around we had excellent fruit maturity and the overall quality makes the wines from the 2021 vintage good candidates for aging potential.
WINEMAKING	<i>Blend</i>	50% Syrah, 40% Grenache, 9% Sauvignon Blanc, 1% Vermentino
	<i>Description</i>	Slightly crushed with minimal skin contact maceration and a gentle champagne direct pressing. Fermentation and aging in 90% stainless steel, 10% neutral oak. 4 months burgundian style 'batonnage' once weekly.
