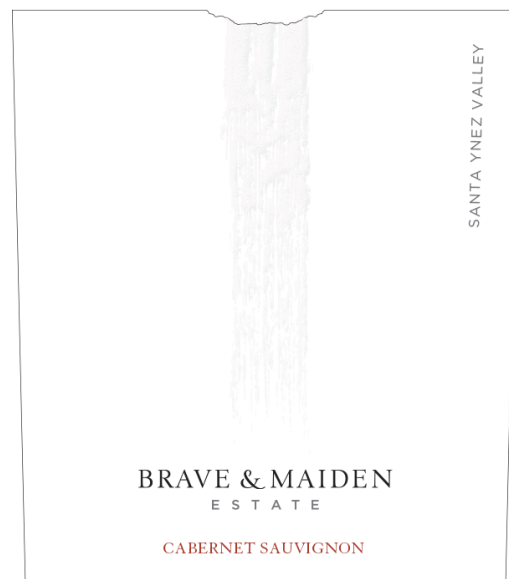


BRAVE & MAIDEN

2013 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

From this opaque red wine emerges aromatics of smoke, ripe plums, caraway, pine needles, and graphite. A balanced and velvety wine with bright, mouthwatering notes of stewed blackberries and kirsch cherries. The finish bears earthy notes of mocha, cinnamon and sandalwood.



VITICULTURE

<i>AVA</i>	Santa Ynez Valley
<i>Year Planted</i>	2011

<i>Clone(s)</i>	169, 4, 15
<i>Harvest Date</i>	11 October
<i>Vintage Notes</i>	2013 was a very dry year due to low rainfall. We saw early bud-break throughout the vineyard while the usual marine layer, generally present through the growing season, was mostly absent. The warm season accelerated the ripening of all varieties, but made for a bountiful, well-ripened harvest.

WINEMAKING

<i>Blend</i>	80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12 % Cabernet Franc, 5% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot
<i>Description</i>	De-stemmed and hand-sorted whole berries to 2-4 ton fermenters, fermented for 14 days and extended maceration for 3 weeks. Barreled down to 100% French oak, 60% new and aged for 19 months.

<i>pH</i>	3.54
<i>Total Acid</i>	6.13 g/L
<i>Residual Sugar</i>	none
